The Formentera Office of Youth Affairs is pleased to announce the activities organised at the Casal de Joves during the month of December. Vanessa Parellada, councillor of youth affairs, asserted that, "once again the Casal has lined up many proposals so kids can enjoy the Christmas holidays with friends in their own space and with activity leaders there to guide them".

The first activity, on Friday 2 December, is a screening of *CODA*. With this eight-minute and eight-second short, young people will be able to reflect on the life of Paula, a daughter of deaf parents who lives between two worlds - one where people hear, one where they do not. Then, "A silent voice" tells the story of a deaf doll who is bullied when she changes schools. With this activity, the Casal adds its voice to International Day of Diversely-Abled People.
